PLC PATHWAYS—All students are set on pathways that meet their individual needs. There are 6 PLC flexible Pathways which range from 100% academic and/or vocational to 100% intervention based; as a result of significant circumstances and/or life events that limit the CYP being able to access learning at this time. The intent is to move CYP through the pathways as quickly as possible with the ambition of returning to mainstream school, or transitioning successfully to an appropriate specialist placement or post 16 provision. All pathways have access to the curriculum offer outlined above.
