# **End of year information pack**

Dear Parents/Carers,

As we reach the end of the summer term I write with thanks to all of you in our school community for your support, patience, resilience and determination during what has been another exceptionally challenging year. I'm sure none of us believed we would be ending a second academic year with the uncertainty of what next year will bring. We have had to learn new ways of working and cope with new ways society has to now function. As ever, our young people amaze us with how they have coped and shown great resilience throughout this time.

You should have all received a text message reminding you that the school year will end with a slightly early finish of **12.30pm on Tuesday 20 July 2021**. Transport has been adjusted to collect students at this earlier time.

We hope to see an increasing return to 'normal' routines in September, but we will be guided by any Government advice over the summer break and we will update you on any changes where required. In the meantime, I would like to outline in this letter, the anticipated arrangements for September 2021 at Pathways Learning Centre.

#### Summer holiday programme

For those parents interested in accessing summer holiday programmes for your children, South Gloucestershire Local Authority have a range of holiday and food clubs available throughout the summer holiday. Many are free, if children are entitled to free school meals, and others are available to young people, but may come with a cost. #### September 2021 arrangement

#### Term dates

There will be two INSET Days for staff on Thursday 2 September and Friday 3 September 2021, so school will begin again for all students on **Monday 6 September 2021**. This includes students' off site or home tuition sessions, although they may start back on a different day during the week, depending upon individual timetables. This will be communicated to you separately. All other term dates and INSET dates are listed below.

#### Bubbles, zones and class sizes

At this stage, we anticipate being able to relax bubbles and zones in September. We are fortunate to have small class sizes anyway, therefore, we will be able to return to our usual class sizes (typically 6-8). We will review any guidance over the summer, as we anticipate that there may be general advice about maintaining 2m social distancing where possible and wearing masks at busy times. #### **Responding to suspected Covid cases**

We will continue to follow the Local Authority and Public Health guidance for schools, regarding how we should respond to suspected Covid cases that occur in school. The Local Authority has also asked us to circulate a letter to parents, regarding updated information and advice about the ongoing rise in Covid case numbers in South Gloucestershire. This letter is included in the pack and can also be found on the PLC website under 'Parent info'.

#### Timetables and group arrangements

- Cotswold groups Timetable arrangements for Cotswold groups have been finalised and a
  copy of the individual timetable is included. Students will start at 09.30 and finish at 15.15.
  Transport arrangements will continue as normal, for those students entitled to transport to
  school. Any queries regarding the Cotswold provision should be directed to Heather Beach
  who will be happy to help.
- Fosse (Primary) groups Pupils will start at their usual time of 08.45 and finish at 14.15 each day. Transport arrangements will continue as normal. Any queries regarding the Fosse (primary) provision should be directed to Cassie Perryman who will be happy to help.
- Frome groups all on site pupils will start at their usual time of 08.45 13.45. Some students will attend PLC for the 'Late Programme' between 2pm 4pm. These details will be confirmed with you separately. Transport arrangements will continue as normal. If you have any questions, please contact Gareth Jones or Connie Coppin who will be happy to help.
- Home tuition Individual timetables have been drafted and are included in this pack. We will of course try, wherever possible, to keep continuity; but the very complex nature of the organisation of Pathways Learning Centre and the individual needs of students at home, makes it extremely difficult to predict where and when staff will need to be utilised. It is also likely that Home tuition sessions will continue with a blend of face to face and on line or virtual sessions. This will allow us to offer students more sessions throughout the week, by reducing the amount of travel time tutors are using. There will be more information to follow from Jo Noott and the Home Tuition team in September.
